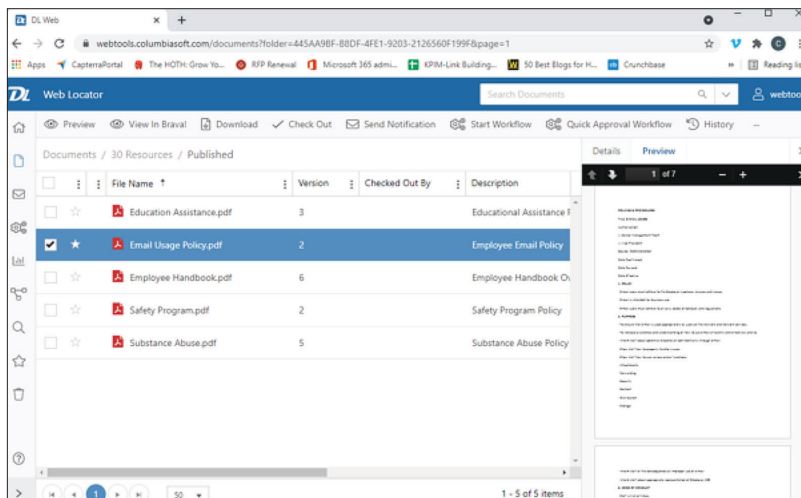

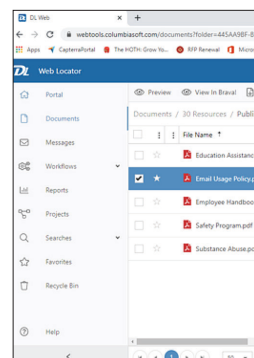
Improved web browser experience

The entire user experience of Document Locator's WebTools has been improved, making it easier than ever to navigate and find files in the browser edition.

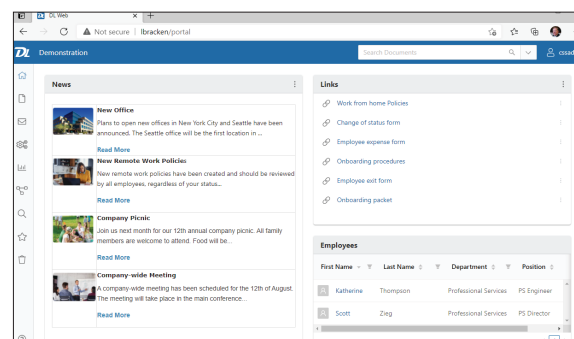
- New user interface with consolidated navigation and breadcrumbs

Menu and breadcrumb navigation replaces tree-and-folders.

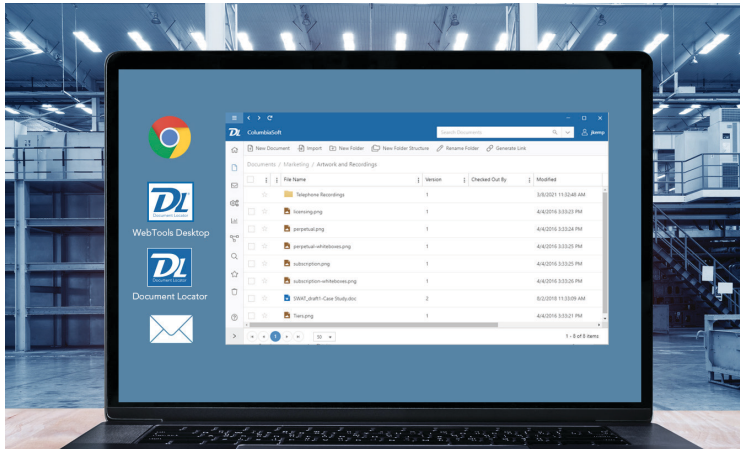

SSO and MFA

Document Locator Version 21.1 supports single-sign-on (SSO) in Desktop, Web, and Mobile for both on-premise and hosted systems, and also allows for multi-factor authentication (MFA) using SAML or OIDC. Users can conveniently log in using their Office 365 account without the hassles of creating separate credentials, while multi-factor-authentication adds an extra layer of security.

WebTools User Manager

Document Locator Version 21.2 adds new user management options into WebTools and WebTools Desktop, allowing for many of the same user configuration options that are available in the desktop edition.

Enhancements in Windows-integrated desktop edition

Desktop client users of Document Locator benefit from several improvements in version 21.

File details at a glance

File details, including metadata, notes, workflows, dependencies, and records policies are accessible in a newly updated right-side information window.

Previews of files enhanced

New preview technology improves viewing of PDFs and image files like TIFs with the ability to scroll through pages.

Send files for approval

Right-click and immediately send files for simple approval without the need to configure a workflow.

Email approval

From the Outlook toolbar, messages can be routed first through Document Locator for approval before being sent.
